Israeli experts assess damages of the areas affected by Eta and Iota as part of the reconstruction effort



Responding to the international call of President Juan Orlando Hernández, to request humanitarian aid for the thousands of victims left by the damage caused by tropical storms Eta and Iota; The government of Israel sent a team of experts to provide professional assistance and guidance in rehabilitation process of the affected areas, these team is currently working in 49 municipalities of Santa Bárbara, Cortes and Yoro, benefiting some 2.7 million Hondurans.

The group is made up of 17 retired officers from the Israeli National Front and is headed by the commander of the National Search and Rescue Unit, Colonel Golan Wach, this contingent was also joined by experts in natural disasters from the non-governmental organization Cadena Mexicana.

The Mexican Army and Air Force transferred 15.2 tons of humanitarian aid to Honduras, from donations received from Hondurans living in that country, the Mexican community in general, honorary consuls and diplomatic personnel from concurrent embassies for Honduras based on Mexico, among others. This is a reflection of the solidarity that exists between the people of both countries. The donation consists of food, hygiene and cleaning products, medicines, clothing, shoes, bedding, and items for the care of children and women.

The cargo was received at the "José Enrique Soto Cano" Air Base, in Palmerola, Comayagua, by Undersecretary of Cooperation Karen Najarro, who thanked the enormous solidarity for those affected. Meanwhile, in a statement, the Mexican Secretary of Defense and Foreign Affairs said that this action sums up the expressions of support from Mexico to the Honduran people.



Financial Support



Through the Central Bank of Honduras, the Kingdom of Morocco and Colombia contributed USD 120,000 thousand dollars.

After the destruction throughout the country and the thousands of victims that were left by the natural phenomena Eta and Iota, many foreign governments, international organizations and companies responded to the call of President Juan Orlando Hernández, making contributions and donations as humanitarian aid. The Kingdom of Morocco and the government of Colombia, made contributions of USD 50,000 thousand dollars and USD 70,000 thousand dollars respectively.
